**WMSC COVID-19 Update**

**November 2nd, 2020**

First off, WMSC would like to thank everyone for their continued support and participation during these unprecedented times. The Club continues to monitor the ongoing news and information in regards to COVID-19 and how it affects soccer. We are also in constant communication with the City of Waterloo and Ontario Soccer to make sure we are up to date with our procedures. The utmost importance during this is the safety of the players, coaches and all involved.

The Club would like to share some friendly reminders in regards to the procedures and protocols for the use of the indoor fields at RIM and Bechtel:

1. Spectators are not permitted on the indoor field at RIM Park or Bechtel Park.
2. As per the City of Waterloo, parents are not permitted to view sessions from the hallways.
3. Attendance will be taken at the field by skills instructors or the coaches for contact tracing purposes.
4. **Recreational players** must complete the COVID-19 checklist within [PowerUp](#) prior to entering the facility.
5. **Competitive players** must complete the COVID-19 checklist within TeamSnap prior to entering the facility.
6. Players will be required to sanitize their hands prior to entering and leaving the field. The sanitizer will be available at each field.
7. Masks must be worn to enter RIM Park and Bechtel Park, and in any common areas. During the program, players are strongly encouraged to wear their face masks. At this time, it is not mandatory to wear a face mask during training. If your child will be removing their mask during training, the advice provided by medical practitioners is to ensure it is kept in a zip-locked bag or small Tupperware container where it can be sealed. If this is decided for your player as an option, please have them bring one of the above with them to put their mask into whilst on the field.
8. Only one person at a time is permitted in the washrooms, and change rooms will not be available.
9. Please be on time for your session. Players will be met outside Entrance D at RIM Park and at the loading dock at Bechtel Park by the City of Waterloo Field Ambassadors will provide entry to the facility once all players have arrived.
10. There is no re-entry or in/out privileges permitted.
11. Participants must remain in the designated rental space only (fieldhouse) and are not permitted to wander throughout the building.
12. No participants shall spit, blow their nose freely or release any bodily fluid anywhere in the facility.
13. Participants are to follow all facility floor markings and signage.
14. Sports bags are permitted but must maintain distance between each bag and may not be piled on top of each other.
15. Participants are encouraged to bring their own filled water bottles. There will be limited bottle refilling stations open should participants need to refill their bottles.
16. All participants must vacate the facility within five (5) minutes from the end of the rental period.
