



### **WMSC Vaccine Certification Screening Process**

According to WMSC's Proof of Vaccination Policy, all participants in WMSC programming who are **12 years old and older** will be required to provide proof of vaccination along with an acceptable form of ID.

#### **Prior to your arrival at RIM or Bechtel Park -**

- 1) For contact tracing purposes, all participants (WMSC staff, players, coaches, match officials, coaching staff, etc) **must complete** the required pre-screening questionnaire either through Power Up for the Recreational division, or Team Snap for the Competitive and Skills Centre programs.

#### **When you arrive at RIM Park -**

- 1) All participants entering and exiting RIM will do so from Entry Door "D". Do not enter/exit from any other exterior door/s.
- 2) All Players ages 12 and older, Coaching Staff, Match Officials and club staff must provide proof of vaccination when entering RIM for their first session. Proof of vaccination will be recorded by WMSC staff in our data base.
- 3) City staff will continue to **check all vaccinations for anyone 18 and over every time** you visit the facility. **Please be sure to have your proof of vaccination with you at all times.**

#### **When you arrive at Bechtel Park -**

- 1) All participants entering Bechtel will do so from the lower ground level side door and exit from the upper main level entry doors. Do not enter/exit from any other exterior door/s.
- 2) All Players ages 12 and older, Coaching Staff, Match Officials and club staff must provide proof of vaccination when entering Bechtel Park for their first session. Proof of vaccination will be recorded by WMSC staff in our data base.
- 3) City staff will continue to **check all vaccinations for anyone 18 and over every time** you visit the facility. **Please be sure to have your proof of vaccination with you at all times.**

**Participants can only enter the facility during their scheduled time but build in extra time to allow for necessary screening and vaccine verification when visiting RIM and Bechtel Park.**

### **Proof of Vaccination -**

An individual is considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 if:

a) They've received:

- the full series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized by Health Canada, or any
- combination of such vaccines,
- one or two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada,
- followed by one dose of a COVID-19 mRNA vaccine authorized by Health Canada
- three doses of a COVID-19 vaccine not authorized by Health Canada; and

b) They've received their final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days before providing the proof of being fully vaccinated. Vaccine receipts can be printed or downloaded from the provincial booking portal.

### **Identification -**

Acceptable forms of ID must include the name of the identification holder, and date of birth:

- Birth certificate
- Citizenship card
- Driver's licence
- Government (Ontario or other) issued identification card, including health card
- Indian Status Card /Indigenous Membership Card
- Passport
- Permanent Resident card

The name and date of birth on the vaccination receipt must match the name and date of birth on the identification. ***Please have these documents ready to present when entering Rim or Bechtel Park.*** Information will be verified and recorded in our data base.

Between September 22 – October 21, individuals may show either a paper copy or an electronic PDF of their proof of vaccination. Beginning October 22, individuals may choose to use the QR code as issued by the provincial government.

### **Exemptions -**

Exemptions under the Ontario policy include:

- Children under 12 years old;
- Individuals with a medical exemption. A written document from a physician (MD), registered nurse extended class (RNEC), or nurse practitioner (NP) will be required should a medical exemption be requested. The document must include:
  - The name of the individual seeking medical exemption, and must match the name on the presented ID
  - Name and contact information of the MD, RNEC, or NP
  - Logo or letterhead identifying the MD, RNEC or NP
  - Statement that there is a medical reason for the individual's exemption from being fully vaccinated against COVID-19
  - An effective time-period for the medical reason, including the date the individual is seeking access to the facility.

**This screening process is subject to change based on federal, provincial, regional or municipal government policies and guidelines.**
