THE FUTURE WE CAN BUILD TOGETHER

Our strategic plan is built on a foundation of collaboration, reflection, and research. Over the past year, we engaged with players, families, coaches, staff, and Board members to understand our strengths, challenges, and opportunities as a club.

This process included surveys, interviews, and discussions with key stakeholders, as well as a comprehensive analysis completed by a team of eight MBA students from Wilfrid Laurier University, whose work helped shape the insights and direction that follow.

The result is a shared roadmap for the future — one that reflects the voices of our community and the aspirations of everyone who believes in Waterloo United.

At the heart of this plan is a renewed commitment to player development - so that every athlete, at every level, has a pathway to grow and achieve their personal goals. Our success will not be measured by wins or trophies, but by how many players we help reach their next level - whether that means moving from recreational to competitive play, advancing from youth to senior programs, learning another side of the game as a match official, or continuing their journey in post-secondary and professional environments.

The following Strategic Pillars and Goals outline the key priorities that will guide our growth and decision-making over the next three years. Together, they represent the future we can build - united in purpose, driven by quality, and committed to our community.

STRATEGIC PILLAR #1:

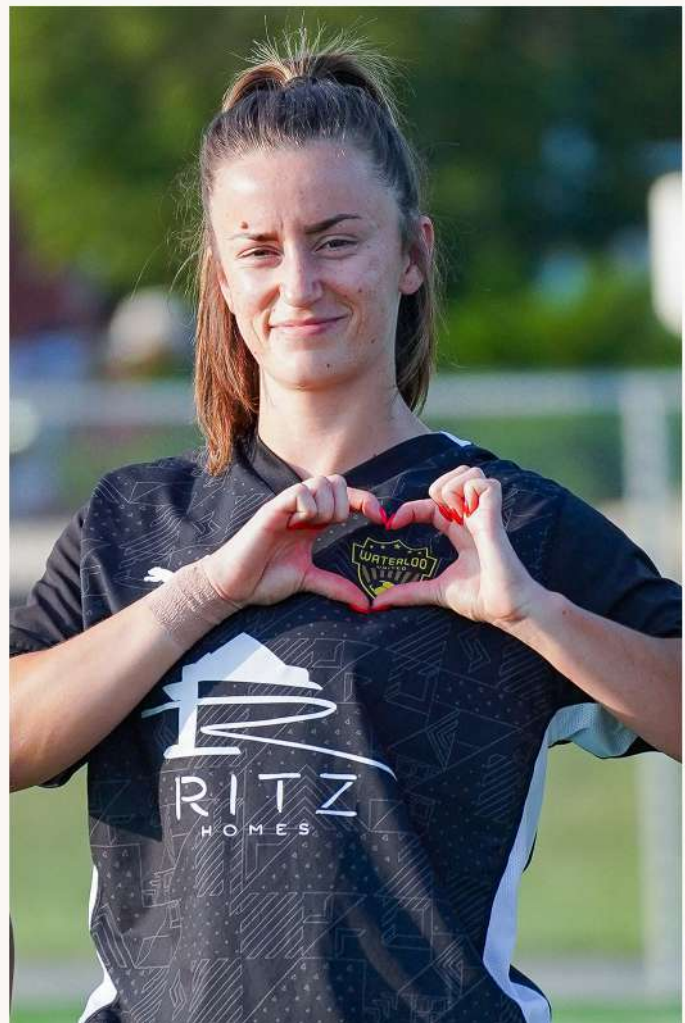
PRIORITIZE PEOPLE DEVELOPMENT

Our commitment to development extends beyond players. It includes coaches, staff, and the entire club ecosystem. This pillar focuses on empowering people to reach their potential through education, mentorship, and structured growth pathways. By investing in continuous learning and supporting smooth transitions from youth to senior levels, we ensure development will remain the heartbeat of Waterloo United.

Goal 1: Empower Coaches and Staff

- **Sub-Goal:** Implement Individual Development Plans (IDPs) and Annual Performance Reviews for technical and administrative staff.
- **Sub-Goal:** Offer/facilitate at least three educational workshops or opportunities per year for coaches.
- **Sub-Goal:** Establish a coach development model with resources and support to foster learning, growth and better age-appropriate coaching for players.

- **Sub-Goal:** Create opportunities that foster mentorship between experienced and emerging leaders (i.e. players to coaches, etc.)



Goal 2: Elevate Player Development Pathways

- **Sub-Goal:** Help Families Navigate Pathways: launch a post-secondary advisory program that includes helping families navigate decisions on what schools are a good fit for them as student-athletes and how to open communication with those programs.
- **Sub-Goal:** Improve transitions between key stages (U7 to U8, U12 to U13 and U17 to Senior Soccer) with targeted programs, events and player exposure opportunities (ie. Pre-Academy programs, Showcase events, etc.)

Goal 3: Promote Lifelong Involvement in Soccer

- **Sub-Goal:** Expand youth leadership and mentorship programs and opportunities to foster character development and mental health. (ie. Senior youth players assisting in skill centre)
- **Sub-Goal:** Create “player-to-coach” and “player-to-official” pathways to retain members beyond playing years and expand opportunities for people in the game.



STRATEGIC PILLAR #2:

FOCUS ON COMMUNITY IMPACT

Waterloo United is more than a soccer club – it’s a community hub. Through this pillar, we aim to expand access to the game, deepen engagement with our City and Region, and celebrate the role soccer plays in strengthening connection and belonging. By building partnerships, removing barriers, and sharing our stories, we will create a club that reflects and serves the diverse community we represent.

Goal 4: Deepen Community Engagement and Impact

- **Sub-Goal:** Expand Access and Inclusion: launch enhanced financial assistance programs and outreach initiatives to reduce cost barriers.
- **Sub-Goal:** Expand Access and Inclusion: Develop partnerships with at least six local schools and organizations through a ‘Soccer in Schools’ program.
- **Sub-Goal:** Measure and Communicate Impact: Enhance data tracking systems to better understand the demographics we serve, the player and coach pathway, and more accurately measure and report our organization’s impact.

Goal 5: Build Club Pride and Visibility

- **Sub-Goal:** Strengthen Club Pride: increase public presence through local media, digital storytelling, and digital content designed to engage more with members. This includes hosting public events and marketing initiatives in Waterloo.
- **Sub-Goal:** Strengthen Club Pride: establish a clear club identity and cultural framework to which all players, coaches, staff, parents and supporting stakeholders should commit.





STRATEGIC PILLAR #3:

RAISE THE STANDARD OF PLAY

Waterloo United’s soccer identity is the foundation of how we play, coach, and grow. Through this pillar, we will define and implement a consistent philosophy and language of play rooted in passion, attitude, togetherness, and hard work. Our aim is to create recognizable standards on the field, where every player experiences a development-first environment - one that reflects our belief that it’s the player’s game.

Goal 6: Establish a Clear Soccer Identity and Language

- **Sub-Goal:** Define a Waterloo United Soccer Identity rooted in four pillars: Passion, Attitude, Togetherness, and Hard Work.

- **Sub-Goal:** Align all programs - from grassroots to high performance - under one clear language of play.
- **Sub-Goal:** Work with other soccer leaders in our Region to improve the standard of training, development and competition for aspiring young athletes in our community.

Goal 7: Champion Player-Centered Development at All Levels

- **Sub-Goal:** Reinforce a culture where player development comes first. Define clear organizational performance indicators that measure our success based on the success of our players.

- **Sub-Goal:** Continue to build on our technical soccer and sports science expertise to not only support player development, but remain a top National Youth Licensed club.
- **Sub-Goal:** Embed the philosophy of “the player at the heart of every decision” into all coaching and operational frameworks.
- **Sub-Goal:** Build a new grassroots player-development curriculum and program standards for the recreational pathway from U3 to U9.
- **Sub-Goal:** Launch a comprehensive Waterloo United Goalkeeper Academy as a regional centre of excellence. Position the club as the top destination for goalkeeper development in Ontario.
- **Sub-Goal:** Establish regular individual player review and assessment systems to monitor holistic growth and objectively show player progression.

STRATEGIC PILLAR #4:

OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

Behind every great program is a strong foundation. This pillar focuses on strengthening the club’s internal systems, governance, facilities, and financial sustainability to ensure we operate with professionalism and transparency. By enhancing our infrastructure, communication, and accountability, we will create a stable, efficient, and future-ready organization capable of supporting growth at every level.

Goal 8: Strengthen Club Infrastructure

- **Sub-Goal:** Develop a long-term facility strategy for increased indoor field access, training hubs, and ensure equipment is up to standard and accessible.
- **Sub-Goal:** Share a clear plan for the club’s Development Fund and how that will be used and replenished to support continual growth and advancement.
- **Sub-Goal:** Improve online systems and processes including the launch of a new website for effectively sharing information on programs, costs, and a more modern customer journey.



Goal 9: Achieve Financial Sustainability

- **Sub-Goal:** Diversify revenue through sponsorships, grants, and community-driven programs.
- **Sub-Goal:** Build a three-year financial model with reserves, contingency planning and assurance that all programs have long-term sustainability.
- **Sub-Goal:** Explore community partnership opportunities to create more effective and efficient ways to achieve common visions for soccer in Waterloo Region.

Goal 10: Enhance Governance & Communication

- **Sub-Goal:** Establish a Dispute Review and Disciplinary Committee to address complaints and behavioural issues in order to strengthen safeguarding measures.
- **Sub-Goal:** Implement a club-wide communication framework with clear roles and response-time standards.



THE WATERLOO WAY

The next chapter of our club will not be written by one person or one program - it will be written by all of us. Every coach, parent, player, volunteer, and partner has a role to play in shaping the future we want to see.

As we welcome our 55th anniversary, we stand at a defining moment for both our club and Canadian soccer. The foundation built by those who came before us has given us an opportunity - now it's our time to take advantage of it.
